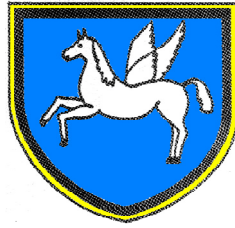

## CURRICULUM

The National Curriculum enables each child to receive a broad and balanced education aimed at the appropriate level. We hope the curriculum offered to our pupils will offer variety and enjoyment whilst preparing them for their future lives as they take their place in society.

The National Curriculum covers Literacy, Numeracy and Science which are known as the core subjects and thus form a major part of what is taught, together with History, Geography, Information and Communication Technology, Art, Music, Design Technology, Personal, Health and Social Education (P.H.S.E.) and P.E. R.E. is also a compulsory subject although it is not part of the National Curriculum.

Children in each year group in Key Stage 2 study three 'topics' a year which have been planned very carefully in order to cover all curriculum content. Children in Key Stage 1 cover five. A variety of methods are used by teachers appropriate to the situation. Whole class, group work or an individual approach are all necessary at times. In literacy and numeracy some teaching is undertaken in ability groups.

We continually review our curriculum in order to keep abreast of new directives and innovations. We aim to provide an inspiring and challenging curriculum that encourages children to enjoy their learning and achieve their very best.
