

## **EXTENDED SCHOOL PROVISION**

Winchelsea is also very proud of the extra opportunities that we provided beyond the normal school timetable. We pride ourselves in being a community school and we have worked hard to develop a comprehensive range of initiatives that are there to support families in our community. We offer family learning opportunities when parents can come into school and access some training to help develop their own skills whilst working with their children. In the past we have run successful numeracy, literacy and I.C.T courses in this way. On Saturdays we have facilitated a group originally run by the YMCA aimed at providing opportunities for Dads to enjoy activities with their children. Activities ranged from sport activities such as football to craft ideas such as building bird boxes for our nature area. We run a Breakfast Club in the morning according to demand and we run an Art and craft club after school to assist parents with childcare. Regular sessions are arranged when the school nurse is here in school to monitor and assess health issues but also to offer advice to families as necessary.

## **PASTORAL CARE**

Winchelsea School has been acknowledged for its high level of pastoral care in our most recent OFSTED report. We strive hard to ensure that children in our care are both happy and healthy and we have a Healthy Schools Award in recognition of our efforts. We promote awareness of health and an understanding of our environment by encouraging children to help us recycle waste and take care of our surroundings. Children are offered fruit at break times and we organise 'Healthy Projects' that involve pupils, parents, staff and outside agencies in promoting all things healthy such as bikeability and pedestrian training. We also encourage children to be active and offer a range of activities to enable them to stay fit and well.
