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Dear Parents/ Guardians,

We're off on our class trip to Conkers soon (Tuesday 4th July)! Here is some updated information for you.

We will be leaving at **8am**, so the children would need to be at school for **7:45am**. We will be leaving Conkers at 4:30pm and so have an estimated arrival of 6:30pm at school, depending on traffic.

Lunch

The children will need a packed lunch. It is strongly advisable that this is in a disposable bag, with disposable packaging (not Tupperware!) so that the children do not have to carry items with them after lunch. Anything the children do bring will be entirely their responsibility to carry. Please ensure that bags, bottles, clothing and wallets are all named. Free school meals children have a pack-up provided, although they may bring their own, or any extras.

PLEASE MAKE SURE THAT YOUR CHILD HAS ENOUGH DRINK FOR THE WHOLE DAY

Spending Money

There is a souvenir shop and the children will have some time to spend in there, so they will be allowed to bring spending money. This amount is up to you, although I would think £5 is more than enough, certainly no more than £10.

Bus Journey

The children should not have chocolate and fizzy drinks. They will also not need any entertainment or snacks for the bus. Any children who might suffer from travel sickness, need to take their tablets before coming to school in the morning, any further medication should be in a named bag or envelope and handed to Miss Reid.

Clothing

As this will be a very active day, the children will need to be in trainers, or similar sporting footwear, and sporty bottoms. They will need their Winchelsea t-shirts and jumpers. It is not forecast for rain or sun – just good old English clouds! Temperature will be ranging from 15° - 18°. The decision about coats will be left to you.

Asthma

Please ensure that if your child suffers from asthma, that they have their inhalers with them.

The children do not need their mobile phones. You may contact the school with any queries and concerns. All adults will have their phones and school will be able to contact us at any point.
