Dear Parents

Once again the reputation of our school choir and dance group has spread further afield and we have been invited to take part in the Children's Schools' Festival in Lincoln on Monday July 3rd. The children and staff have been practicing hard to develop a repertoire of songs and dances to entertain their audiences.

We have performed at this event in previous years which involves schools from across the county who will be performing in different venues around Lincoln during the festival which lasts for five days. We will be performing in the main High Street, not far from the Waterside Shopping Centre and if it rains we will be inside! Each school will perform for approximately half an hour in a marquee which will be wired with an outdoor sound system so accompaniment music can be played from CDs with additional microphones for the children's voices. The children will arrive by bus and be collected by the festival organisers, street wardens and Police Community Support officers who will escort them across busy roads.

When the children are not performing they have been invited to take part in a drama workshop run by a local company who will work with our children for approximately half an hour. Our performance takes place at 10.00am and after that we will watch another school perform, and then we will attend our workshop at 11am. Our bus will collect us at midday and we should return to school for afternoon lessons.

Children will need to wear smart school uniform, have a coat in case of inclement weather and bring a packed lunch and a drink in a suitable container. Sweets, chocolate or fizzy drinks are not permitted. Children will not need any money.

As the children will be leaving the school site I will need a permission slip to be completed. Please be aware that the organisers or local press may be taking photographs during the event. Please indicate if this is a problem and I will ensure that the organisers are aware.

At this stage I am not sure whether there will be any spare seats available on the bus to offer to parents that might like to join is. On return of permission slips I will let you know. Of course, we hope you will be able to come along and support us.
