Dear Parent/Guardian,

The time is fast approaching for our visit to London to see Mamma Mia. In this letter, I have tried to cover any questions you may have, however, if I have omitted anything please do not hesitate to ask.

Children are expected to be at school by 8.45am as normal. We will be leaving school at 9.30am.

It is our intention to stop at a service station on the way to London where the children can purchase a hot meal (MacDonalds, Pizza Hut or KFC). We usually ask you to send your child with £5 in a clearly marked envelope, to be given to their group leader. The children will need a pack up for the return journey as we are hoping to travel back with only a quick toilet stop. If you do not wish your child to have a hot meal please send enough pack up for two meals. Please ensure you provide your child with plenty of drinks.

We will arrive in London in time for the 3.00pm Matinee. We hope to be back at school for approximately 10.30pm.

It may be possible to buy souvenirs at the theatre and so there will be no restriction on spending money. Please send your child's hot meal money in a separate envelope and their group leader will look after it for them.

Children may bring cd players, ipods, ds, psp etc for the journey. **Strictly NO mobile phones** Children are **completely responsible** for their own money and personal items. Staff cannot afford to replace everyone's lost money! Whilst on the bus, children may have sweets/snack but absolutely **no** fizzy drinks or chocolate.

Please note that this is a ***uniform day***, and your child will require a coat.

If your child suffers from any medical problems i.e. travel sickness, hay fever etc. please could you inform Mrs Jones ASAP. Any child suffering from asthma, ***must bring their inhaler with them.***
