Please make sure names are on everything! This way things can be returned if they get lost.


What will I be learning ?

Literacy-This term we will focus on recounts, using words such as first, then, next, after that, finally. We will also continue to focus on our sentence structure, using capital letters and full stops whilst adding appropriate detail.

Maths - the children will look at place value this term, recognising the value of each digit in a two digit number to 99 and beyond. They will also look at the four number operations of addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.
