Dear parents and carers

## Wellbeing

On Wednesdays, we have wellbeing assemblies. We recently have been focusing on safety. Yesterday, Mrs Dunham talked to the children about sun safety, this included covering up, drinking lots of water and wearing sunscreen. We gave children hats and water bottles to use outside. Please encourage your children to wear sunglasses, hats and sunscreen. If your child brings sunscreen into school, please ensure that it is named. Over recent weeks we have also talked to the children about road safety and water safety.

We are aware that some children have been playing on scooters and bikes outside of school without wearing helmets and on the road. We urge you to encourage your child to follow safety advice outside of school. Please also note that some children have been seen on electric scooters, which are not suitable for primary school children and are in fact illegal.
