Welcome back to the summer term! This week we have all taken part in recycling and 'Let's talk rubbish' waste workshops, which were led by Lincolnshire County Council to help children understand the importance of recycling. Well done to our Year 1 children who have completed their phonics screening checks and Year 4 for completing their multiplication checks. Results will be shared with the end of year school reports.

This term we will be trialling different forms of feedback to help support our children to improve their learning. The children have enjoyed beginning to mark their own work and being teachers by marking their partner's work in maths. They will be looking at ways to edit and improve their writing also.

The team have been supporting individual pupils and our 'wellbeing buddies' with their mental health and wellbeing in school.

This then means that staff can follow the guidance given by doctors and log accordingly. This is to safeguard both pupils and staff. We thank you for your co-operation on this matter.

We have been reminding the children to drink more water and wear sun hats, but we politely ask you to ensure that your child has sun cream on before they come into school and can bring some to re-apply (with their name on).
