In arts, we will be exploring innovative ways in which we can create an Ancient Egyptian scroll.

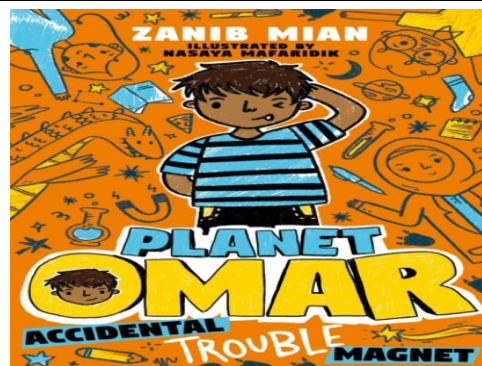
Our music sessions will continue with Mr Roberts as the children use a range of instruments when playing a collective piece of music.
