Welcome back, Emerald!

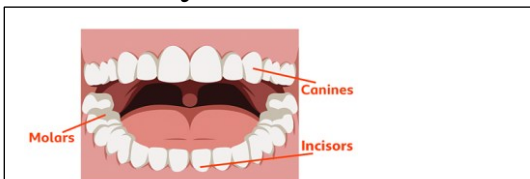
This half-term, we will be helping children consolidate routines and learning about many new topics, including many exciting Christmas activities!

Please ensure your child has their indoor and outdoor kits every day as poor weather could alter our plans.

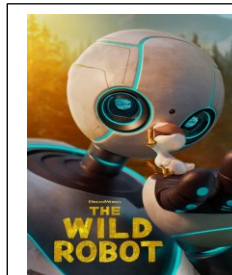
