This half-term, we will be helping children settle into Year 4 and establish routines.

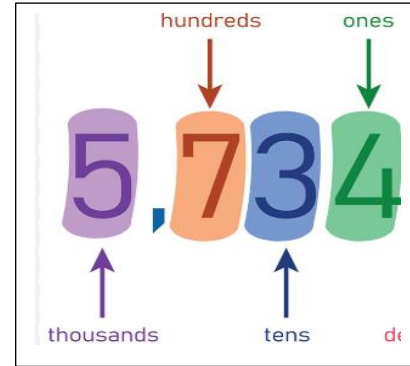
I am really looking forward to getting to know the class and helping them on their learning journey. Mrs Morley is excited to be working with the class again.

In humanities, we will be exploring the invaders and settlers who have made the British Isles their home over the centuries. We will study the Romans and how their arrival changed Britain



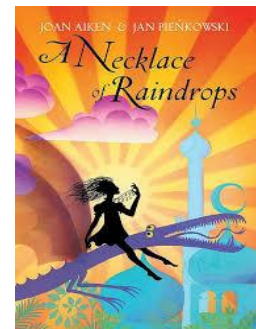
In writing lessons, we will be consolidating the writing skills learned in Year 3, such as writing with more complex sentences and editing.
