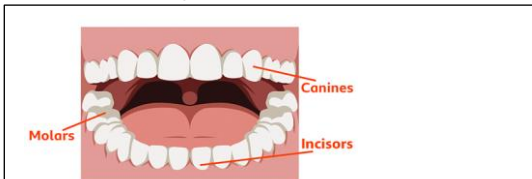
In history, we will learn about the Saxons and the Vikings.

Our PE days will be Mondays and Wednesdays.

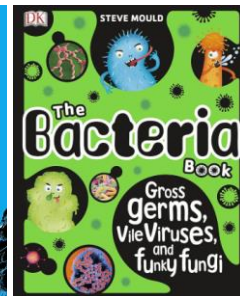
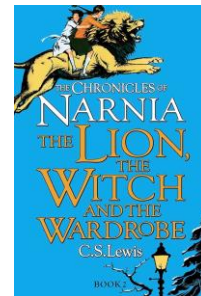
