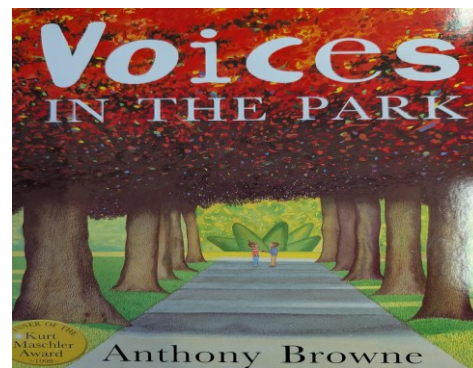
'All individuals matter'
