This half-term, we will be learning about many new topics.

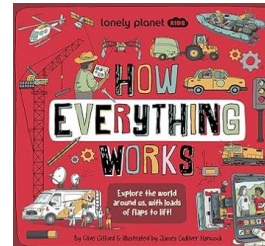
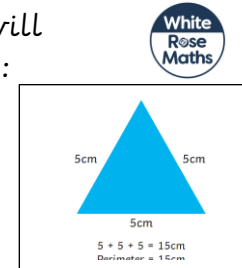

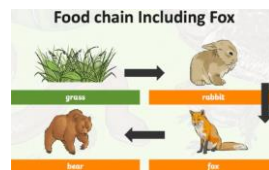
'All individuals matter'
