English

In English, we are sharpening our comprehension and inference skills through some exciting exploration of lighthouses while also preparing confidently for the SATs through different types of comprehension papers.

In writing, pupils will explore narrative writing (stories) that include direct speech and story telling through their own characters. We will also be polishing up our grammar skills, ahead of the SATs.

Humanities (Geography): Biomes

Year 6 geographers are continuing their journey into different biomes and climate zones from around the world. Through hands-on activities, creative projects and thoughtful discussion, pupils will learn about ecosystems, environmental challenges and how we can protect these precious habitats for the future.



Maths: Decimals, Fractions and percentages; area perimeter and statistics

Our budding mathematicians will be applying their knowledge and making connections in our next unit: decimals, fractions and percentages. We will then be moving onto area and perimeter and then ending the term with a unit on statistics.

There will be a strong focus on arithmetic skills in stand-alone lessons on a Friday and problem solving and reasoning skills in preparation for SATS. Please ensure your child knows their times tables confidently!

Science: Living things & classification

Building on our knowledge from last term, we are looking at living things and what classification groups they fit in. We will be looking at weird and wonderful creatures and plants of the world through the Linnaeus' system.
