Examine the various text examples to see how an information text is constructed.

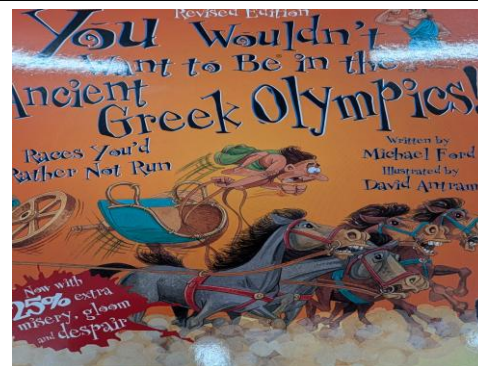
We will comment on the structure of various texts and examine how non-fiction books are used to provide us with information.
