In music, we will be *developing instrument skills on the TooT* with Mr Roberts.

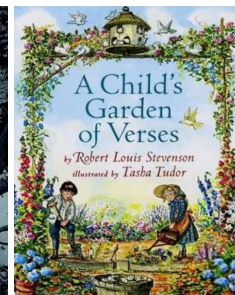
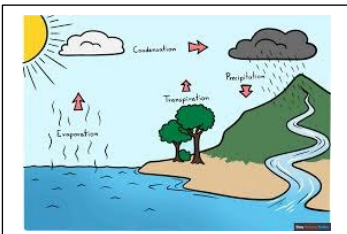


We will be learning about *kickball* and *striking & fielding*.
