We hope you're looking forward to returning to school on the 1<sup>st</sup> June 2020; it will be strange in these ever-changing times. One of the things that will change is the school's hot meal provision. The Farm Kitchen has kindly offered to provide a hot meal when we return – a jacket potato as the main option with different hot fillings for the first fortnight (subject to change dependent upon the uptake). Other schools have opted for a packed lunch so this is a unique offer.

Parents will need to book this provision from The Farm Kitchen (see details below).

If you have never ordered a meal through The Farm Kitchen you will need to register on their website. If you can't remember your log in details, please contact The Farm Kitchen direct to request a reset of your account.

**Please note the order deadline is Tuesday 26<sup>th</sup> May 2020 by 3pm for w/c Monday 1<sup>st</sup> June 2020.**

### **Reception & Year 1**

- You will not automatically receive a hot meal so please remember to book,
- The meal will still be offered for free under the Universal Free School Meal Scheme.

### **Free School Meal (FSM) entitlement**

If you are entitled to FSMs you will have been receiving shopping vouchers from EdenRed during the lockdown. Upon returning to school, you will no longer be entitled to a voucher even if you choose not to take up the offer of the hot meal from The Farm Kitchen. If you have children in other year groups, you will continue to receive a voucher for them until they return to school.

Please note, in addition to this, the school will not be offering break time milk or fruit. You will need to provide your own fruit if you want your child to have a snack. If you would like your child to bring in bottled water rather than their water bottles having to be topped up throughout the day, this is acceptable.

The situation is constantly being re-evaluated and changed according to government guidance. We will update you further if we receive anything new.
