The Government has informed us that schools must close to the majority of pupils again as of tomorrow (Tuesday 5th January) except for the pupils of key workers or those classed as vulnerable i.e. in receipt of an Educational Health Care Plan or allocated a social worker.

The best advice is to stay away from public areas, including schools, and remain in your own homes. However, we understand that some frontline workers, who are working hard to combat this virus, may need our support. If you think this applies to your circumstances, please complete this form and return AS SOON AS POSSIBLE TO YOUR CLASS TEACHER

We intend for children to complete the same work as their peers will do from home, but in the school setting. Details about remote learning provision were explained in the newsletter that was sent out today but you will receive further, more specific information, from your child's class teacher.
